

Before you come to our office, you start by filling out a medical and dental history to initiate your individualized oral risk assessment.

When you arrive, your risk assessment is reviewed and then an oral examination is performed in which 4 different aspects of your oral health are evaluated. These are the health of your gum and bone, the structural integrity of the teeth themselves, the way your teeth meet together when you chew, and how they are positioned when you smile. This comprehensive exam evaluates the risk of your oral health and the prognosis of having your teeth outlive you, assuming you will live to be 101 years old.

You can then determine for yourself how much risk you would like to assume, and then the treatment can be determined to go with the level of risk you are comfortable with. Depending on the treatment chosen, more information may be needed, such as mounted models, Photos, Cone beam imaging, etc. Most of the time, treatment can be completed quickly or staged to make your choices fit your budget.
